Application of ATX Licensing, LLC for Approval of
the Discontinuance and Abandonment of
Telecommunications Services to the Public in the
Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On August 7, 2025, ATX Licensing, LLC (“ATX” or “Company”), utility code 310992, filed an Application seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience (Certificate) pursuant to Section 1102(a)(2) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1102(a)(2), evidencing Commission approval of the discontinuance and abandonment of Competitive Local Exchange Carrier (CLEC) and Interexchange Carrier Reseller (IXC-R) services to the public in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

ATX is currently certificated to provide telecommunications services as an IXC-R (statewide) and as a CLEC in the service territories of Verizon Pennsylvania LLC and Verizon North LLC at Docket Nos. A-310992F0002 and A-310992, respectively. The Company’s Certificates of Public Convenience were granted on August 17, 2000 (IXC-R) and October 25, 2000 (CLEC). ATX proposes to discontinue and abandon the provision of CLEC and IXC-R services within Pennsylvania.

The Company avers that it has no active customers and does not plan to provide services in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.¹ ATX avers that it served its last customer prior to 2022.²

ATX is current on all assessments, reports, and regulatory fees. The Company has submitted the required filing fee of \$350 with the Application pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.43. There are no NXX codes affected by this Application.

A copy of the Application was sent to the Office of Consumer Advocate, the Office of Small Business Advocate, and the Office of the Attorney General as evidenced by the Certificate of Service submitted with the Application. No protests were made since the Application was filed and no hearings were held. In addition, no motions or petitions were filed in this proceeding.

Upon full consideration of all matters of record pertaining to the Application, we find that approval of the Application would be in the public interest. Upon abandonment, all rights and privileges as a public utility existing under the Certificates now subject to abandonment in Pennsylvania including but not limited to all rights and privileges with eminent domain authority, zoning exemptions, and public right-of-way occupancy, shall be revoked; **THEREFORE,**

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Application of ATX Licensing, LLC is hereby approved.

2. That a Certificate of Public Convenience be issued pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 1102(a)(2) authorizing the Discontinuance and Abandonment of Competitive Local Exchange Carrier and Interexchange Carrier Reseller services by ATX Licensing, LLC to the public within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, as specified in the Application.

3. That the Secretary's Bureau cancel and remove ATX Licensing, LLC's tariffs from the active files and that ATX Licensing, LLC be removed from the active lists maintained by the Bureau of Technical Utility Services and the Bureau of Administrative Services.

4. That upon issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience authorizing ATX Licensing, LLC's Discontinuance and Abandonment of Competitive Local Exchange Carrier and Interexchange Carrier Reseller services in Pennsylvania, ATX Licensing, LLC rights and privileges as a Pennsylvania public utility, including but not limited to all rights and privileges with eminent domain authority, zoning exemptions, and public right-of-way occupancy, are revoked.

5. That a copy of this Order be served on the Bureau of Registration and Taxpayer Management in the Pennsylvania Department of Revenue and Pennsylvania Emergency Management Agency 911 Office.

6. That this case be marked closed.
