Dear Secretary Homsher:

Enclosed for filing on behalf of National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation (“National Fuel” or the “Company”) is Supplement No. 294 to National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation Gas Tariff – PA P.U.C. No. 9 (“Supplement No. 294”). In Supplement No. 294, National Fuel is seeking a base rate increase pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. § 1308 of the Public Utility Code of approximately \$19.7 million. If the Company’s entire request is approved, the total bill for a residential customer using 80 ccf per month would increase from \$83.49 to \$88.44 per month, or by 5.9%. Supplement No. 294 contains an issue date of January 28, 2026, and an effective date of March 29, 2026.

The Company’s filing includes a proposal to reinstate a tariff rider that would provide a refund of Other-Post Employment Benefits (“OPEB”) funds of approximately \$6.2 million to all customers and also provide a one-time bill credit of \$30, totaling approximately \$1.025 million, to Customer Assistance Program (“CAP”), Level 1, and Level 2 customers.

This filing also includes a request for approval of the following alternative rate mechanisms in accordance with Act 58 of 2018, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1330: (1) Weather Normalization Adjustment; and (2) Energy Efficiency pilot program. The Statement of Reasons and Direct Testimony explain why the Company is making this base rate filing at this time. The filing also includes the supporting data required by 52 Pa. Code §§ 53.52 and 53.53.




