Pursuant to the final inspection of work conducted by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission on January 7, 2026, for the subject mentioned docketed proceeding A-2023-3041540, please find the attached enclosed revised plan sets for the docketed record showing the new placement of the detectable warning surfaces per Norfolk Southern and Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission direction.

At the inspection on January 7, 2026, it was noted that the original installed location of the pedestrian warning surfaces for the multi-use trail that was constructed as part of the project were placed beyond the railroad warning lights and stop bars. This is a public safety issue, and NP Gun Club Building 1, LLC (Developer) has since removed and replaced the pedestrian warning surfaces as per the attached revised plan sets to a safer location for pedestrians and cyclists.
