The Bureau of Audits has reviewed Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc.'s proposed Supplement No. 409 to Tariff Gas – Pa. P.U.C. No. 9 submitted on January 16, 2026 to become effective February 1, 2026.

Based upon staff review, it appears that the proposed Interim Distribution System Improvement Charge (DSIC) for the two-month period of February 1, 2026 through March 31, 2026 is consistent with the tariff and, accordingly, is permitted to become effective as filed.

The DSIC is subject to continuous Commission review and audit as well as reconciliation reports in accordance with Section 1307(e) of the Public Utility Code, 66 Pa. C.S. § 1307(e).

Pursuant to the Commission's regulations at 52 Pa. Code § 5.44 (relating to petitions for reconsideration from actions of the staff), you may appeal by filing a petition for reconsideration with the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter.
