Dear Attorney Bakare:

By Opinion and Order entered January 15, 2026 (January 15 Order), the Commission authorized Citizens' Electric Company of Lewisburg (the Company) to file a tariff supplement containing rates, rules, and regulations consistent with the Joint Petition for Non-Unanimous Settlement (Settlement) filed in the above docketed rate investigation, as modified consistent with the January 15 Order, and designed to produce annual electric distribution operating revenues of approximately \$7,446,470. On January 28, 2026, the Company filed Supplement No. 177 to Tariff Electric PA. P.U.C. No. 14 to become effective January 29, 2026, as well as updated Settlement Appendices and workpapers, in compliance with the January 15 Order.

Commission Staff has reviewed the tariff revisions and found that suspension or further investigation does not appear warranted at this time. Therefore, in accordance with 52 Pa. Code Chapter 53, the supplement is effective by operation of law as of the effective date contained on each page. However, this is without prejudice to any formal complaints timely filed against said tariff revisions.
