

**MOTION OF FIRSTENERGY PENNSYLVANIA ELECTRIC COMPANY
FOR CONTINUANCE OF HEARING**

TO THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:

FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company (“FE PA” or the “Company”) by and through its attorney, Angelina Umstead, and pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b), hereby files this Motion for Continuance of the hearing currently scheduled for March 4, 2026. In support thereof, the Company avers as follows:

I. BACKGROUND

1. On or about December 22, 2025, Jennifer Flach (“Complainant”) filed a Formal Complaint with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) regarding 616 Charles Drive, Gilbertsville, Pennsylvania 19525 (“Service Location”) under Account No. 100049481680 (“Account”).

2. On January 12, 2026, the Company filed its Answer denying the material allegations.

3. On January 15, 2025, Administrative Law Judge Alphonso Arnold III (“ALJ Arnold”) issued a Prehearing Order setting an initial telephonic hearing date of March 4, 2026.

4. The Company's witness is scheduled for another formal complaint hearing during the same date and time.

5. On January 27, 2026, the Company reached out to the Complainant to discuss the continuance request. The Complainant stated that she is agreeable to a continuance of the hearing.

6. As such, the Company respectfully requests that the hearing scheduled for March 4, 2026, in this matter be continued to a later date.

II. MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE


7. The Commission's regulations permit a request for continuance of a hearing upon good cause shown. 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b).
