

Request for Information

The previous application made by your company was dismissed for failure to provide requested information regarding the frequency and retention of checks regarding drivers. The Commission provided the relevant statutory citations and relevant guidance for the applicant to reference when preparing its revisions. In the response to the Commission's data request the applicant was unable to provide policies for the hiring/employment of its drivers that complied with the Commission's regulations.

- 1) The responses to questions 5(a), 5(b), 5(c), 5(d) and 5(e) of the verified statements are insufficient. Title 52 Pa. Code § 29 provides detailed requirements. Please provide a system which incorporates code specified compliance requirements in regard to frequency and retention of those driver records. Each of your answers to sections of this question were insufficient:
 - § 29.504. Driver history
 - § 29.505. Criminal history.

As an additional note:

- A) Some companies have found great difficulty in providing the Liability Form E for a leased vehicle which is mentioned in your application. Great care should be taken to ensure your insurer can provide that form, a Permit to operate will not be issued without that document filed at the required time.
- B) A signed contract between your company and PennHighlands will also be required before a Permit can be issued. Please make sure to be working on those details.
