ORDER
GRANTING RESPONDENT’S MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE

On December 22, 2025, Jennifer Flach (“Ms. Flach”) filed a Formal Complaint against FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company (“FE PA”) with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission seeking a payment arrangement.

On January 12, 2026, FE PA filed an Answer to the Complaint, admitting or denying the allegations of the Complaint.

On January 15, 2026, the Commission issued a Hearing Notice setting this matter for an evidentiary hearing on March 4, 2026, and assigned me as Presiding Officer. A Prehearing Order setting forth the procedural guidelines for the case was issued the same date.

On February 2, 2026, FE PA filed its Motion of FirstEnergy Pennsylvania Electric Company for Continuance of Hearing. In its Motion, FE PA sought continuance of the evidentiary hearing due to the unavailability of its witness on the hearing date. In its Motion, FE PA indicated Ms. Flach was agreeable to a continuance of the hearing.

The Commission’s regulations provide that continuances will be considered only upon “good cause” shown. 52 Pa. Code § 1.15(b). I agree with FE PA that the unavailability of its witness on the hearing date is good cause to continue the hearing. Further, it has also been considered that Ms. Flach agreed to continuance of the hearing.
