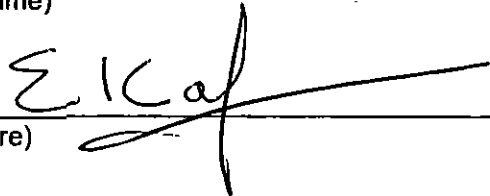

10) Future Days LLC for the right to begin to transport, as a common carrier, by motor vehicle, persons in limousine service from points in the Counties of Lackawanna and Luzerne to Harrisburg International Airport (MDT), Lehigh Valley International Airport (ABE) and the Wilkes-Barre / Scranton International Airport (AVP) and vice versa. Future Days LLC will contact the PPA to apply for the permit so we can provide service to The Philadelphia International Airport from points in Lackawanna and Luzerne counties.

3) I have several years of experience in the ground transportation industry; I currently have a PUC license (A-6426846). I have authority to transport in a paratransit service in addition to airport transport service.

4) I currently maintain a office in my home complete with a printer and laptop. I purchased a software package to help me manage the entire booking process. The software is called "Limo Anywhere", customers can book online, text or call me personally. The drivers have an App to communicate with the passengers. I also use QuickBooks to record revenue and expenses.

All vehicles are rigorously maintained as needed, safety in this company is a priority, they have GPS tracking devices so I can track the vehicles during service, and it provides alerts when the vehicles are close to needing a service appointment.

I also have a AAA subscription for any emergency while driving.

5) Currently we have 8 part-time drivers, they have over forty years of driving experience and possess the skills necessary to provide a safe and smooth experience for our customers no matter where the destination may be.

We have monthly meetings to review the trips, and we discuss ways to improve our service in addition to speaking about safety.

I also have motor vehicle records on all the drivers in their respective files. A clean report for the driver is required prior to starting, we will continue to review every year from the last report date.

Future Days LLC will have a third party conduct a local and national background check for each driver. A copy of the record will be maintained by Future Days LLC for at least 3 years.

After a trip is complete, I also ask our customers to send a brief review about the experience and service they received from the driver. Copies of these records will be maintained by Future Days LLC.

8) I have commercial auto insurance on both vehicles. Policy number BA177841#1.

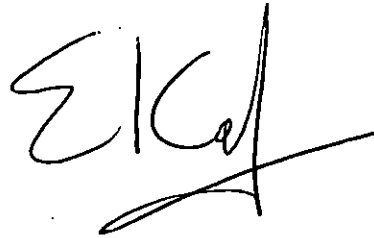

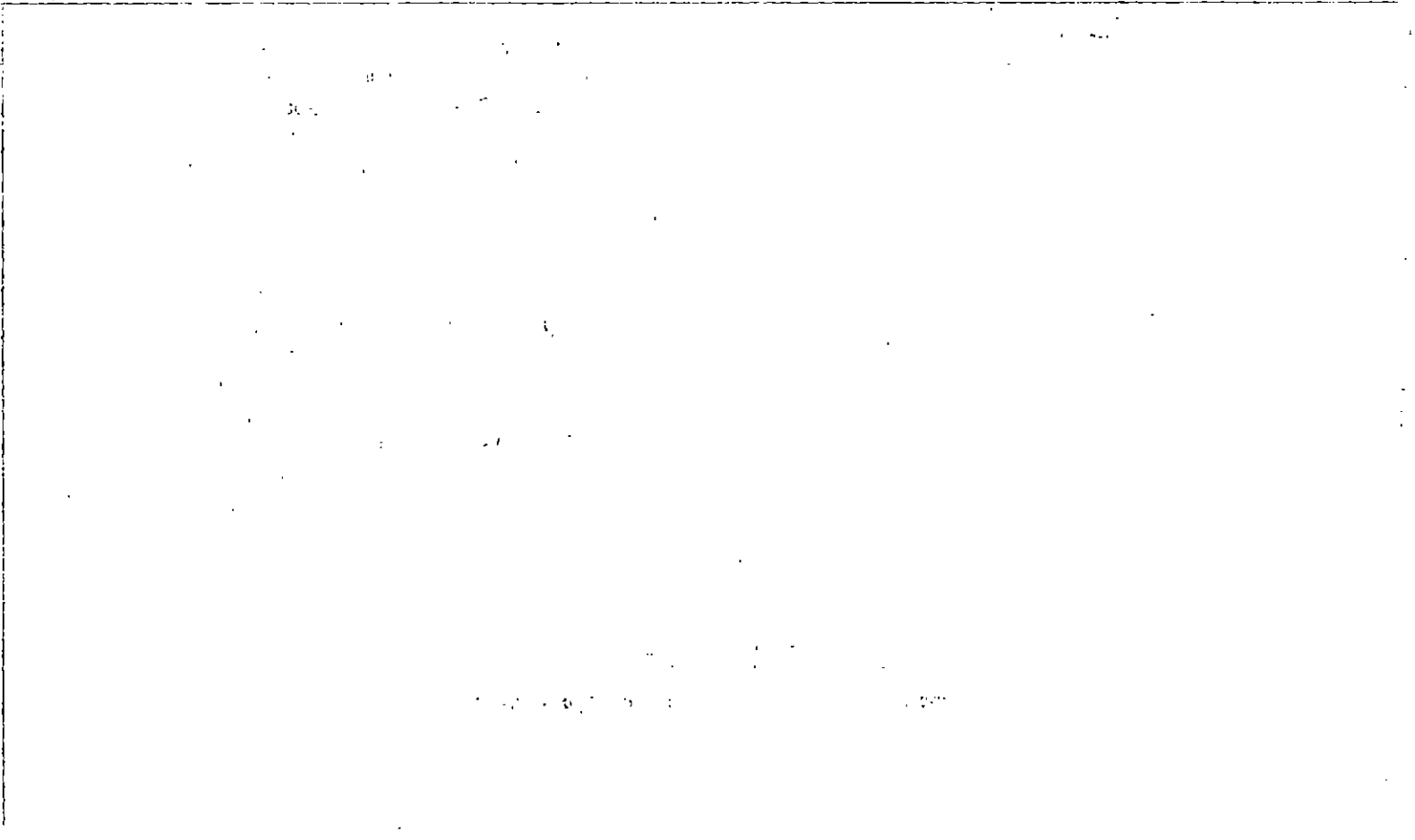

1. This application is required to operate as a commercial carrier of persons in luxury vehicles seating no more than 10 when providing transportation between points in Pennsylvania. Applicants seeking to provide service between points in the city and county of Philadelphia or from any airport, railroad station or hotel located in whole or in part in Philadelphia, must apply to the Philadelphia Parking Authority. 2. Upon approval of the application, you will be notified that prior to providing service in Pennsylvania you must submit evidence of insurance to the Public Utility Commission. **Your permanent evidence of insurance will be a Form E for bodily injury and property damage insurance.** This form is mailed to the Commission directly from the home office of your insurance carrier. The name and address on your Form E must **exactly** match the name and address you have provided on your application. Your insurance company must subscribe to the NIC Insurance Filing website at www.nicinsurancefilings.com . You will request the insurance company (not the agent) to file the required insurance forms electronically through NIC. Mailed insurance forms are no longer acceptable. The minimum limits of insurance are as follows:
