RE: Notification of the Transfer of Two Commercial Customers

Dear Ms. Tunilo:

On October 1, 2025, Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. (Columbia Gas) filed with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) a notification of the transfer of two commercial customers, located at 45 Prestley Road and 56 Prestley Road, Bridgeville, Pennsylvania 15017, from Columbia Gas to The Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC (Peoples).

By Order entered on July 12, 1977¹, (1977 Order), the Commission granted Equitable Gas Company, Columbia Gas, and Peoples approval to transfer certain residential and commercial customers between the companies when such transfers were occasioned by line renewals, highway construction, urban development, or to eliminate the duplication of facilities. The 1977 Order directed the utilities to provide written notification to the Commission no later than forty-eight (48) hours after the occurrence of such transfers.


Columbia Gas states that the subject transfers were undertaken to eliminate the duplication of facilities, consistent with the 1977 Order. Columbia Gas indicates that the affected customers were notified of the proposed transfer on April 22, 2025, and that no objections were received. Columbia Gas further states that Peoples was advised of the transfers. By Notices filed on January 16 and January 23, 2026, Columbia Gas confirmed that the transfers of the customers located at 56 Prestley Road and 45 Prestley Road to Peoples were completed on January 14, 2026, and January 22, 2026, respectively.
