Request for Information

- 1.) Question # 10 of the Application. Personal convictions: This wording should only be used in reference to religious sects like the Amish community, where their religion prevents them from owning or operating vehicles. This language does not refer to people who cannot drive for any other reason. Please refer to the attached list of territory/service templates on the last pages of this data request for helpful examples and let us know your intent or verify that the example below (which would give the Corporation an unrestricted customer base with the Commission) is what you now intend.

Example: *To transport persons, by motor vehicle, in Paratransit service, from points in the city and county Philadelphia, to points in Pennsylvania, and return.*

- 2.) Question #2 Verified Statement. A statement of ownership is not requested here. We need you to list the Company's relationship with other motor carrier companies here.
- 3.) Question #3 Verified Statement. The description of your transportation experience was vague; can you please provide details about the past transportation industry experience?

4.) Question # 5 of the Verified Statement. Provide compliant 52 Pa Code driver hiring and employment policies. 52 Pa Code can be accessed at www.pacode.com. Please review the chapters below before answering.

A.) § 29.503. Age restrictions. Will drivers have to be at least a certain minimum age?

B.) § 29.504. Driver's license checks. (frequency): Will this be done initially and explain the schedule? How will you make sure they are done on a set schedule?

C.) § 29.505. Criminal history. (frequency): Will you be using the PA State Police "Patch" program? How often will this be done after the initial check? What are the disqualifications of employment? How will you make sure this is on a set schedule?

D.) § 29.506 Alcohol prohibition and § 29.507 Controlled substance prohibition. Who will be conducting drug/alcohol tests? How long will a driver have to wait after using alcohol and/or substances, before the driver will be permitted to drive?

- E.) Finally, explain your policy regarding your driver training program. Please furnish the program on separate pages and attach it to your reply to us.
- 5.) Question #7 of the Verified Statement. Please identify what exactly the monthly inspections would entail and who will be conducting them. Please refer to 67 Pa Code, Chapter 175 prior to answering.
- 6.) Question #8 of the Verified Statement. Provide evidence of a commercial insurance quote.
- 7.) Financial Position.
- A.) The information provided is to be strictly limited to assets and debts held by the applicant (Pantrails Logistics Corporation), and not the individual member(s). Any property listed must be registered or titled to the corporation – personal property should not be included. If the applicant was previously unfunded, then now is the time for the applicant's accounts to be filled. Any assets which may need transferred to the applicant should happen prior to adding them to the Balance Sheet. Please resubmit a corrected Balance Sheet, if the applicant erroneously co-mingled assets and debts, with an explanation of what has changed and why.

B.) If your previously submitted Balance Sheet is accurate provide proof of ownership of the claimed property and vehicles, such as registration, title, purchase agreement, etc. or remove personal assets from the Balance Sheet. All proof must be in the name of the Corporation.

C.) Please specify what the \$150,000 amount represents in the other current assets designation.

- Information is to be exact and should not include estimates or approximations when accurate numbers are available. Make sure the math is correct.

D.) To be clear, Pantrails Logistics Corporation has a commercial loan in the amount of \$280,000 due within one year?

E.) To be clear, does Pantrails Logistics Corporation have a long-term loan in the amount of \$30,000?

F.) To be clear, Pantrails Logistics Corporation is paying a mortgage in the amount of \$3,000 total?

G.) Lastly provide supporting documentation to verify the reported cash assets of \$150,000. Acceptable means of support include current copies of bank statements or notarized/official statements of account balances/ownership provided by bank officers (with current contact information) in the name of Pantrails Logistics Corporation (account numbers may be redacted).

Note: It is the responsibility of the applicant seeking motor common carrier authority to demonstrate that it possesses the financial ability to provide the proposed service. As per 52 Pa. Code §41.14, applications may be denied if the applicant fails to satisfy fitness standards. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your consultation with an attorney or financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier-related proceedings is highly encouraged. It is in your best interest to provide accurate, complete, and timely responses.

**PASSENGER CARRIER TERRITORY EXAMPLES AND EXPLANATIONS:
The Public Utility Commission is specifically concerned with the location in**

which trips by your company will ORIGINATE. Your requested territory must have boundaries and are typically requested by County / Counties.

Take care in choosing the correct language. You must file a new application and pay an additional fee to amend any approved territory.

Examples below:

1) To transport persons, by motor vehicle, in Paratransit service, from points in (County name/names here), to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

This territory means that you are not limited to a vehicle type, not limited to the type of activity regarding non-emergency medical transportation, or transportation for virtually any reason. This language would give your company the broadest customer base to work from.

2) To transport persons, by motor vehicles, in Paratransit service, in wheelchair vans, between points in (County name/names here).

This territory means that you must:

- a) provide all services in wheelchair vans, and
- b) could travel only between points within the county or counties requested as your territory. You could not leave those counties and return.

3) To transport persons, by motor vehicle, in Paratransit service, limited to persons whose

personal convictions prevent them from owning or operating motor vehicles, from points in (County name/names here), to points in Pennsylvania, and return.

This language is strictly for companies that specialize in transporting Amish people, this is NOT to be used for persons who are elderly and cannot drive, or who do not have a vehicle for any other reason.
