Application of Upper Nazareth Township for approval to alter the crossing (DOT 851 943 H) where Gun Club Road (T-506) crosses, at grade, the tracks of the Norfolk Southern Railway Company, located in Upper Nazareth Township, Northampton County.

To Whom It May Concern:

By Secretarial Letter dated February 2, 2024, and Secretarial Letter amended dated February 16, 2024, the Commission approved the subject application, allocation of costs and assignment of the future maintenance responsibilities.

A final inspection conducted by a Commission staff engineer on January 7, 2026, revealed that not all physical work had been completed satisfactory to the parties.

On January 15, 2026, NP Gun Club Building 1, LLC, submitted as-built plans for this Commission's affirmation. The plans represent as-built conditions for the removed and new locations of the pedestrian detectable warning surfaces at the location of the subject captioned public crossing. The parties were served with a copy of the as-built plans none of the parties filed an objection to the affirmation of the plans with this Commission.

The plans are hereby entitled "PROPOSED WIDENING AND RESURFACING OF GUN CLUB ROAD EXISTING RAILROAD CROSSING FOR UPPER NAZARETH TOWNSHIP" consisting of two (2) sheets.

Please be advised that the above-stated plans have been certified as the correct plans and are hereby affirmed.

On January 28, 2026, NP Gun Club Building 1, LLC, notified a Commission staff engineer that all outstanding work has been completed satisfactorily and provided photographic evidence of the new locations of pedestrian detectable warning surfaces.

We have carefully reviewed the record in this proceeding and are of the opinion that a public hearing is not necessary inasmuch as all work has been satisfactorily completed and the affected parties of record have not requested a hearing for any unresolved issues or reimbursement for any costs incurred by the project.

The Commission issues this Secretarial Letter in accordance with Section 2702 of the Public Utility Code and finds that since all work has been completed, the case be “CLOSED.”

The Parties are reminded that failure to comply with this or any Order or Secretarial Letter in this proceeding may result in an enforcement action seeking civil penalties and/or other sanctions pursuant to 66 Pa. C.S. § 3301.



If your filing contains confidential material, you are required to file by overnight delivery to ensure the timely filing of your submission. There are certain filings that cannot be eFiled, such as filings containing confidential or proprietary material. These must be submitted to the Secretary by overnight delivery, priority, or certified mail to allow tracking of your filing.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.31 and 5.44, file a Petition for Reconsideration from Staff Action (Petition) with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. The Petition shall be eFiled with the Secretary of the Commission or sent to: Secretary, PA Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120, and must be filed within twenty (20) days, or if no timely request is made, the action will be deemed to be a final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request; (2) the case docket number (it is provided for you at the top right-hand corner of this letter); (3) the party on whose behalf the petition is made; (4) a Certificate of Service on the other parties of record; and (5) a Verification with original signature in accordance with 52 Pa. Code § 1.36.
