**JOINT STATUS REPORT**

**TO THE PENNSYLVANIA PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION:**

Pursuant to the Interim Order issued on December 16, 2025 (“Interim Order”), Duquesne Light Company (“Duquesne Light” or the “Company”) submits the following Joint Status Report to the Administrative Law Judge Mary D. Long (the “ALJ”). Duquesne Light Company submits this Status Report on its behalf as well as on behalf of Jefferey Kashuba (the “Complainant”) (collectively, the “Parties”).

**I. Introduction**

On December 16, 2025, the Parties attended the initial telephonic hearing scheduled in this matter. In lieu of a formal proceeding, the Parties both participated in a settlement discussion. While settlement discussions were productive, a finalized settlement was not reached. The Parties requested additional time to execute the terms of a settlement.

On January 20, 2026, the Company submitted a Joint Status Report to the ALJ, requesting a continuance, noting that settlement discussions have been productive. On January 21, 2026, an Interim Order was issued granting the request for a continuance.

## II. Status Report

Settlement discussions between the Parties are no longer productive. Additionally, Mr. Kashuba has requested a hearing.


