On August 6, 2025, you attempted to file a document purporting to be a Petition for Reconsideration of the Commission's April 18, 2025, denial of your Application for Paratransit Authority at Docket Number A-2025-3053246. In accordance with 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.41 and 5.44, Petitions for Reconsideration to Staff Action must contain certain definable information and must also be filed within 20 days of the service date of the Secretarial Letter Denying the Application. In the above captioned case, a Petition for Reconsideration was due to be filed by the close of business (4:30 p.m. EST) on May 8, 2025.

Your Petition for Reconsideration to the Commission's April 18, 2025 Secretarial Letter Denying the Application was not received by the Commission until August 6, 2025. Additionally, your submission failed to include the minimum filing requirements for petitions. Therefore, your filing is rejected for failure to comply with 52 Pa. Code §§ 5.41 and 5.44 and is being returned to you under cover of this letter. See 52 Pa. Code § 1.38. Notwithstanding the above rejection of your purported Petition for Reconsideration, you may still seek a certificate of public convenience by filing a new application for paratransit authority along with the required filing fee and required documentation in support of your application.

The case at the above docket is now closed.
