On January 22, 2026, UGI Utilities, Inc. (UGI) filed the result of its Request for Proposals (RFP) Process and Rules for the Winter 2026 Solicitation for provider of last resort service. The filing includes the proposed bid result for a 12-month full requirements power RFP for Residential and Small Commercial and Industrial customers who receive default service from UGI during the period of June 1, 2026, through May 31, 2027.

This filing was submitted in accordance with UGI's Default Service Plan V RFP Process and Rules filed on May 31, 2024, as part of a Joint Petition for Non-Unanimous Settlement. The RFP Process and Rules were approved as modified by the Settlement in the Commission's Order, entered February 20, 2025, at Docket Nos. P-2024-3049343 and G-2024-3049351.


UGI requests that the Commission approve the bid result of the Winter 2026 Solicitation on or before January 23, 2026.
