

The same cargo listed above that is related to our business- metal, building materials, machinery, construction- are also transport for hire cargo.

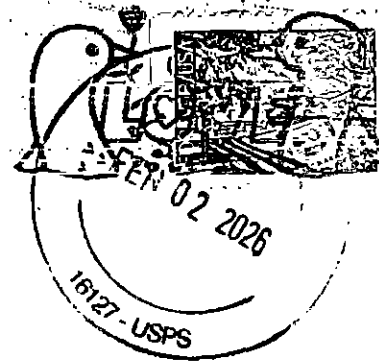
Any business that would contract us for the transport of that cargo would also reimburse us for that service.
