

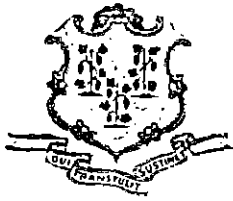

By Decision dated July 26, 2023, the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority (Authority) granted AEC Energy LLC (AEC) an electric aggregator certificate to serve non-residential customers. AEC is obligated to comply with all relevant statutes, regulations, and Authority Decisions.

Order No. 6 of the Decision required AEC to file as compliance on or before September 6, 2023, contracts that comply with Orders No. 2, 3, and 5. To date, AEC has not made such a compliance filing in its licensing docket.

General Statutes § 4-182(c) states:

"No revocation, suspension, annulment or withdrawal of any license is lawful unless, prior to the institution of agency proceedings, the agency gave notice by mail to the licensee of facts or conduct which warrant the intended action, and the licensee was given an opportunity to show compliance with all lawful requirements for the retention of the license."

Based on the foregoing, AEC is directed on or before **August 9, 2024**, to file compliance associated with Order No. 6 of the Decision. Pursuant to General Statutes §§ 16-41 and 16-245(l)(6), the Authority may pursue penalties, including but not limited to certificate revocation, if AEC fails to meet its obligations.

I. INTRODUCTION

1. By this Order, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) grants a license to AEC Energy, LLC d/b/a AEC Energy Management (“AEC” or “Applicant”) to function as an electricity supplier in the District of Columbia.¹ The license for AEC Energy, LLC d/b/a AEC Energy Management is effective upon issuance of this Order.

II. BACKGROUND

2. On January 31, 2023, AEC filed its license application.² Specifically, AEC intends to operate as a broker of electricity pursuant to § 4601 in Chapter 46 (Electricity Suppliers) of Title 15 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations.³ The Applicant represents that it intends to serve commercial and industrial customers in the District of Columbia. AEC filed supplemental information on February 27 and March 23, 2023.⁴

III. DISCUSSION

3. Our review of the information contained in AEC’s application and supplemental filings demonstrates that it has met all the prescribed licensing requirements and that the Applicant has the ability and financial integrity to serve
