Request for Information

- 1.) Question #10 of the application. The territory/service needs to fit a certain language and template. Also, interstate trips are not under the jurisdiction of the Commission and should not be mentioned in the description. Revise your request or verify that the below example is what you now intend.

**Example:** *To transport, by motor vehicle, persons in Limousine service, from Lehigh and Northampton counties to points in Pennsylvania and return, excluding service that is under the jurisdiction of the Philadelphia Parking Authority.*

**FYI-** TNC Authority cannot use PUC certified carriers and/or a vehicle that is registered commercial.

- 2.) Question #2 Verified Statement. A statement of ownership is not requested here. We need you to list the Company's relationship with other motor carrier companies here.
- 3.) Question # 5 Verified Statement. You may be an owner operator, but the Commission needs to know you have a satisfactory plan in place should you choose to expand after certification. Provide compliant policies that satisfy the requirements of 52 Pa Code with revision to the specific chapters below. 52 Pa Code information can be reviewed online at [www.pacode.com](http://www.pacode.com).

A.) § 29.503. Age restrictions. Will drivers have to be at least a certain minimum age?

B.) § 29.504. Driver History. How often will a driver license checks be done?

C.) § 29.505. Criminal history. How often will record checks be done and what are disqualifications of employment?

D.) § 29.506. Controlled substance prohibition and § 29.507 Controlled substance Prohibition. What are your policies about alcohol and drug use by your drivers?

E.) Finally, explain your policy regarding your driving training program beyond saying that only will be offered and completed.

4.) Financial Position.

A.) Your Balance Sheet should consist solely of assets and debts held by the company, not assets and debts held or attributable to the company's individual member.

Properties featured on the Balance Sheet must be titled to Smooth Travels LLC. If you have not yet transferred suitable funds into the company name, then now is the time to do so. Please resubmit a corrected Balance Sheet reflecting acceptable updates

if the applicant indeed co-mingled assets and debts, with an explanation of what has changed and why is required.

- Information is to be exact and should not include estimates or approximations when accurate numbers are available.

B.) Please submit an improved balance sheet that shows that Smooth Travels LLC has financial fitness to provide safe, efficient, and reliable service. Approval of your application cannot be considered with only \$2,500 cash in the business account.

C.) Please provide supporting documentation for the improved balance sheet. Acceptable means of support include current copies of bank statements or notarized/official statements of account balances provided by bank officers (with current contact information) in the name of Smooth Travels LLC. (account numbers may be redacted).

D.) Submit verifiable proof of ownership of the land/building, such as titles, purchase agreements, etc. or remove these assets from the balance sheet. All proof **MUST** be in the name of "Smooth Travels LLC".

E.) Include proof of ownership of the vehicle(s) with a copy of a title and/or registration in the name of the applicant (Smooth Travels LLC).

F.) To be clear, \$10,000 is due within one year as reported under the corporate credit card designation.

- You are encouraged to enlist professional financial assistance if you have trouble in constructing your statement of financial position.

**Note:** It is the responsibility of the applicant seeking motor common carrier authority to demonstrate that it possesses the financial ability to provide the proposed service. As per 52 Pa. Code §41.14, applications may be denied if the applicant fails to satisfy fitness standards. Be advised that additional corrections may not always be requested; therefore, prior to submitting your responses, your consultation with an attorney or financial expert familiar with Commission regulated Motor Carrier-related proceedings is highly encouraged. It is in your best interest to provide accurate, complete, and timely responses.
