- 1.) In your previous response to a Commission data request, you stated that a DUI conviction within the past five (5) years would be a disqualifying offense for one of your drivers. While not specifically stated under the regulation found at Title 52 Pa Code §29.505(a)(3), it stands to reason if a period of time is given for disqualifying a driver for a DUI it should be in line with the regulation given at Title 52 Pa Code §29.505(b)(1)(i)(A). Please provide a compliant policy for disqualifying a driver who was previously convicted of driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
