Driver DUI Disqualification Policy (Pennsylvania-Compliant)

In accordance with **52 Pa. Code §29.505**, Fampro Care Transport LLC maintains the following policy for disqualifying drivers convicted of driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol.

Any driver applicant or current driver who has been convicted of driving under the influence (DUI) of drugs or alcohol, as defined by Pennsylvania law, within the previous five (5) years is disqualified from operating a vehicle.

A DUI conviction that occurred more than five (5) years prior may be considered only after review of the driver's complete motor vehicle record and confirmation that all court-imposed requirements have been satisfied.

Any DUI conviction occurring during employment results in immediate disqualification from driving duties.

Your answers should be verified per 52 Pa Code § 1.36. Accordingly, you must provide the following statement with your responses:


I, Lean Fan Fan, hereby state that the facts above set forth are true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information and belief, and that I expect to be able to prove the same at a hearing held in this matter. I understand that the statements herein are made subject to the penalties of 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904 (relating to unsworn falsification to authorities).

The blank should be filled in with the name of the appropriate company representative, and the signature of that representative should follow the statement.

Failure to comply with this request within 10 working days from the date of this letter will result in the denial of the application.
