**FURTHER PREHEARING ORDER
ON SERVICE OF PROPOSED EXHIBITS**

On October 14, 2025, John Fulton (Complainant) filed a formal complaint against CNX Resources Corporation (CNX or Respondent). Complainant stated that CNX failed to properly restore the surface of his road while replacing a water pipeline. As relief, he wants CNX to repave the road.

By hearing notice dated December 8, 2025, this matter was assigned to me and scheduled for a telephonic hearing on January 29, 2026.

CNX filed an answer denying the material allegations¹ of the complaint and preliminary objections. Respondent’s preliminary objections were dismissed.

In preparing for the hearing, I noted that I had not received copies of the Respondent’s exhibits in an accessible format. Mr. Fulton’s photographs received on January 9, 2026, were not pre-marked and would be very difficult to discuss over the telephone in the present format. Accordingly, I notified the parties by email that I would be issuing an order cancelling the January 29, 2026 hearing and directing the parties to confer and provide

alternative dates when all parties and witnesses are available for a hearing. That instruction was memorialized by interim order dated January 28, 2026.

The hearing was rescheduled for February 24, 2026, and a standard prehearing order was issued. This order sets forth additional instructions for the service of proposed exhibits.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That any party who wishes to introduce photographs into the record for my consideration must provide me with color copies of each photograph **at least five business days** in advance of the hearing scheduled for Tuesday, February 24, 2026. **Each photograph must be pre-marked for identification.** One copy of each pre-marked photograph must also be provided to the other party in this case at least five business days in advance of the hearing.
2. All proposed exhibits must be provided electronically in Adobe PDF, Word, or other easily accessible format. Exhibits must be directly attached to an email. Links to cloud servers or other methods requiring download are not acceptable.
3. Any proposed exhibits which do not conform to the above ordering paragraphs may not be offered and will not be admitted into evidence.
4. All other provisions of the Prehearing Order remain in effect.
