To Whom It May Concern:

The purpose of this Letter is to advise you that your Application, Docket No. A-2026-3060284 has been **DENIED** by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission). The Commission has determined that a Certificate of Public Convenience **WILL NOT BE GRANTED** for the following reason(s):

• **Failure to establish fitness to operate:**

On February 2, 2026, the application of Attentive Medical Transportation, LLC, was accepted by the Commission for review. In analyzing the applicant's submitted balance sheet it has been determined that the applicant lacks sufficient financial fitness to assure the Commission of its ability to offer safe, efficient, and reasonable operations.

The applicant's balance sheet, dated October 24, 2025, indicates cash reserves of only \$1,000. Although the applicant cites a vehicle asset of \$42,000, elsewhere in its testimony it indicates that it has not yet purchased the vehicle. This indicates that either the claimed asset is speculative, or that it is a personal asset of the applicant's sole member. Regardless, as the asset itself would be indispensable to the applicant's operations, neither the applicant's vehicle nor its claimed property assets lend any cash fluidity to the applicant's financial situation.

As such, when considering the outstanding cost of a vehicle purchase, the high cost of paratransit authority insurance coverage, anticipated vehicle maintenance costs, basic operational costs, and the potential for unexpected expenses; it has been determined that the applicant is inadequately funded.

For these reasons the application is DISMISSED and DENIED

APPEAL RIGHTS

If you disagree with this determination, you may send a Petition for Reconsideration of Staff Action to: Secretary, Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission, 400 North Street, Harrisburg, PA 17120. Such a Petition is a written statement asking the Commission to change its determination.

The Petition must be filed with the Commission within twenty (20) days of the date of this letter. If no timely request for reconsideration is made, this action will be deemed to be the final action of the Commission.

The Petition MUST include: (1) a written statement (divided into numbered paragraphs) outlining the reasons for the request, (2) the case docket number(s) (they are provided for you at the top right hand corner of this letter), (3) the name of the person on whose behalf the petition is made, (4) copies of relevant documentation, and (5) a verification with original signature. See 52 Pa. Code §§-1.31 and 5.44.
