Driver Disqualification Statement (PUC-Compliant)

Pursuant to **52 Pa. Code § 29.505(b)(1)(i)(A)**, Fampro Care Transport LLC disqualifies any driver applicant or current driver who has been convicted, within the preceding seven (7) years, of driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol or any other criminal offense that constitutes a disqualifying offense related to public safety.

Fampro Care Transport LLC conducts criminal background checks and motor vehicle record reviews as required to ensure continued compliance with Commission regulations and to safeguard the public and passengers.

Any driver who is convicted of a disqualifying offense during the course of employment is immediately removed from service and prohibited from operating a vehicle on behalf of the Company.

Your answers should be verified per 52 Pa Code § 1.36. Accordingly, you must provide the following statement with your responses:



I understand that the statements herein are made subject to the penalties of 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904 (relating to unsworn falsification to authorities).

The blank should be filled in with the name of the appropriate company representative, and the signature of that representative should follow the statement.

Failure to comply with this request within 10 working days from the date of this letter will result in the denial of the application.
