**NARRATIVE**  
**Zachary Smith 4850**

On 02/20/2025 I Officer Smith (#4850) and Officer Christensen (#4989) were dispatched to 3122 Shadeland Avenue for a harassment report.

Officers met with the complainant Lucien Scott at the residence. He stated that he lives at this residence with his girlfriend Megan Murray and her son, Ethan Reese who was also on scene. Scott stated that he has had recent issues with the landlord of the property, identified as Christopher Old (DOB: 03/02/1993). Scott stated that Old had placed a lock on the electricity and had posted an eviction notice on the front door advising the occupants had 10 days to leave. Scott stated they had since contacted DLC to remove the lock. Scott showed Officers on scene a picture of the eviction notice which was not an official notice to vacate signed by a Judge. Officers are familiar with Old from previous interactions and are aware he owns numerous properties/land in this area.

Scott stated that he and the other occupants have been living at 3122 Shadeland since October 2024. I asked Scott for a copy of the signed lease agreement in order to help verify. He was able to produce a copy of the lease agreement sent to him by Old/ Old's company, however he was unable to find the signed copy. Reese was able to produce mail documents with his name and the address on it. Reese and Scott both claimed that Old has the utilities in his name, however Scott stated he has been trying to get the utilities in his own name. Scott stated he has been unsuccessful in attempts to have productive conversations on the matter with Old.

Officers observed Old parked across the street in his vehicle watching our interaction. Officers then walked over and spoke with Old to get his side of the story. Old acknowledged that these individuals have been living at this residence for months, however he stated they have been late on rent and been failing to pay utilities. Old stated that he put the notice on the door with the intention to move forward with a formal legal eviction through the courts. He stated that the residence is technically not habitable. He stated that utilities had been turned on at certain times without his knowledge, and the accumulation of the utility and rent owed has reached thousands of dollars.

Old was advised that this issue needs to be remedied through a civil process such as a formal legal eviction and Officers could not likely force these individuals to leave. I offered to complete a report for Old that he could use to assist in the process if possible. He was given the CCR#.

Scott informed us that they were currently packing and trying to find a new place to live due to the current difficulties they've faced living at this residence.
