 - Transportation of people whose personal convictions prevent them from owning or operating motor vehicles.
 - Transportation of people to correctional facilities for visitation.
 - Transportation of people in wheelchair and stretcher vans.

****Important Note: Paratransit carriers may not render service to or from airports.***

2. Upon approval of the application, you will be notified that prior to providing service in Pennsylvania you must submit evidence of insurance to the Public Utility Commission. **Your permanent evidence of insurance will be a Form E for bodily injury and property damage insurance.** This form is mailed to the Commission directly from the home office of your insurance carrier. The name and address on your Form E must **exactly** match the name and address you have provided on your application. Your insurance company must subscribe to the NIC Insurance Filing website at www.nicinsurancefilings.com . You will request the insurance company (not the agent) to file the required insurance forms electronically through NIC. Mailed insurance forms are no longer acceptable. The minimum limits of insurance are as follows:

The service area proposed by this application is **Luzerne County, Pennsylvania**. La Bella Transportation LLC intends to provide paratransit transportation services throughout the county, including residential pick-up locations and destinations such as workplaces, employment centers, and other authorized locations within Luzerne County.

Services will be provided between all points within the county boundaries, with routes designed to accommodate scheduled and recurring trips that support daily transportation needs for eligible paratransit passengers.

Examples:

- *To transport people whose personal convictions prevent them from owning or operating motor vehicles from points in Lancaster County to points in PA, and return.*
- *To transport people from the city and county of Philadelphia to correctional facilities in PA, and return.*
- *To transport people in wheelchair and stretcher vans from points in the city of Pittsburgh to points in Allegheny County, and return.*
- *To transport people between points in Northumberland County.*

Application Question 4: Facilities, Record Maintenance Plan, and Communication Network

Answer:

Facilities and Physical Location:

La Bella Transportation LLC operates from its registered business address located at **124 N Cedar Street, Hazleton, Pennsylvania 18201**. This location serves as the administrative office for the company and is used for management, scheduling, recordkeeping, and regulatory compliance activities. The office is equipped with standard business machines necessary to support daily operations, including desktop or laptop computers, a multifunction printer/scanner, secure internet access, and dedicated business telephone service.

Vehicles used in paratransit operations are housed at a designated off-street parking and vehicle storage location within **Luzerne County, Pennsylvania**, which allows for safe vehicle staging, pre-trip inspections, and routine maintenance coordination. Vehicles are not used for the transportation or storage of household goods; therefore, no household goods storage facilities are applicable to this operation.

Record Maintenance Plan:

La Bella Transportation LLC maintains all required Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission records in an organized and secure manner. Records are stored in both electronic and physical formats and include, but are not limited to, driver qualification files, vehicle registration and inspection records, maintenance and repair logs, insurance documentation, service schedules, trip records, incident reports, and customer service documentation. Normal business records such as financial statements, payroll records, contracts, and tax filings are also maintained.

Records are retained for the applicable regulatory retention periods and are readily accessible for inspection or audit by the PUC upon request. Electronic records are protected through password-secured systems, and physical documents are stored in locked filing cabinets at the business office.

Communication Network:

Customer requests for transportation services are received through direct telephone contact and electronic communication methods such as email or pre-arranged service scheduling. Paratransit services are primarily scheduled in advance to accommodate recurring work-related transportation needs.

Vehicle dispatch is coordinated by management through direct communication with drivers using mobile phones. Drivers receive trip assignments, routing information, and schedule updates prior

to and during service hours. Continuous communication is maintained throughout the service period to address schedule changes, traffic conditions, passenger needs, or emergency situations.

This communication structure ensures timely service delivery, driver accountability, and safe, reliable transportation for all passengers served by La Bella Transportation LLC.

Application Question 5: Drivers, Hiring Standards, and Safety Policies

Answer:

Number of Drivers and Appropriateness:

La Bella Transportation LLC intends to utilize **three (2) drivers** at the initial stage of operations. This number is appropriate for the size of the proposed service territory—**Luzerne County, Pennsylvania**—and the nature of the paratransit services being provided. The planned staffing level allows the company to adequately cover scheduled and recurring transportation routes, including home-to-work and work-to-home trips, while also providing flexibility for staggered shifts, service reliability, and coverage in the event of driver absence or vehicle maintenance.

a. Hiring Standards for Drivers:

Drivers are selected based on strict hiring standards designed to ensure passenger safety and service reliability. All drivers must:

- Possess a valid Pennsylvania driver's license appropriate for the vehicle operated
- Have a clean or acceptable driving record
- Be at least 21 years of age
- Demonstrate professionalism, reliability, and the ability to safely assist passengers
- Meet physical and mental fitness requirements necessary to perform paratransit duties

b. System for Conducting Criminal Background Checks:

All prospective drivers are required to undergo criminal background checks prior to employment. Background screenings are conducted in compliance with Pennsylvania requirements and include state and, where applicable, federal criminal history checks. Any disqualifying offenses will result in ineligibility for employment. Background check records are maintained in the driver's qualification file.

c. Driver Training Program:

La Bella Transportation LLC provides initial and ongoing driver training focused on:

- Safe vehicle operation and defensive driving
- Passenger assistance and paratransit service procedures

- Proper conduct, professionalism, and customer service
- Emergency response procedures and incident reporting
- Compliance with company policies and applicable regulations

Training is documented and reinforced through periodic reviews and refresher instruction as needed.

d. System for Conducting Driver License Checks:

Driver license status is verified prior to hiring and monitored on an ongoing basis. License checks are conducted at regular intervals and whenever required to ensure each driver maintains a valid and appropriate Pennsylvania driver's license. Any lapse, suspension, or revocation results in immediate removal from service until resolved.

e. Alcohol and Drug Use Policies:

La Bella Transportation LLC enforces a strict **zero-tolerance policy** regarding the use of alcohol or illegal drugs by drivers. Drivers are prohibited from operating vehicles while under the influence of alcohol, illegal substances, or impairing medications. The company reserves the right to require testing under reasonable suspicion or following an incident, and any violation of the alcohol and drug policy may result in immediate disciplinary action, up to and including termination.

This structured approach ensures that La Bella Transportation LLC maintains a safe, professional, and compliant paratransit transportation operation.

Application Question 7: Vehicle Safety Program

Answer:

La Bella Transportation LLC maintains a comprehensive vehicle safety program designed to ensure that all vehicles used in paratransit service are safe, reliable, and in continuous compliance with applicable Pennsylvania laws and regulations.

a. Periodic Vehicle Maintenance Plan:

All vehicles operated by La Bella Transportation LLC are maintained according to a scheduled preventive maintenance program. Routine maintenance is performed at regular mileage- and time-based intervals and includes, but is not limited to, inspections of brakes, tires, steering, suspension, lights, signals, mirrors, windshield wipers, fluids, belts, and other critical safety components.

Drivers are required to conduct pre-trip and post-trip vehicle inspections each service day to identify any mechanical or safety issues. Any defects or safety concerns are reported immediately and corrected prior to the vehicle being returned to service. Maintenance and repair work is

performed by qualified service providers, and all maintenance activities are documented and retained as part of the vehicle maintenance record.

b. Compliance With Pennsylvania Vehicle Equipment Standards (67 Pa. Code, Chapter 175):

La Bella Transportation LLC ensures continuous compliance with Pennsylvania vehicle equipment and inspection standards as outlined in **67 Pa. Code, Chapter 175**. All vehicles are required to pass state safety inspections and emissions inspections, when applicable, and to display valid inspection stickers at all times.

Vehicle condition is monitored through daily driver inspections, scheduled maintenance reviews, and periodic management audits of vehicle condition and records. Any vehicle found to be out of compliance with equipment or safety standards is immediately removed from service until all deficiencies are corrected and compliance is restored.

This safety program ensures that vehicles remain roadworthy, compliant, and suitable for the safe transportation of paratransit passengers throughout Luzerne County.

Application Question 8: Insurance Availability and Ability to Pay Premiums

Answer:

La Bella Transportation LLC has taken proactive steps to ensure that it can obtain and maintain the insurance coverage required to operate as a Motor Common Carrier of Persons providing paratransit services in Pennsylvania. The applicant has consulted with licensed insurance agents experienced in commercial passenger transportation and paratransit operations to review coverage requirements, including liability limits mandated by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

Based on these consultations, the applicant has obtained insurance quotations and confirmation of availability for the required policies. The company has evaluated premium costs in relation to projected operating revenue and has incorporated insurance expenses into its business budget and financial planning.

La Bella Transportation LLC maintains an active business bank account and has demonstrated the financial capacity to pay required insurance premiums on a monthly or annual basis as required by the insurer. The applicant understands that continuous insurance coverage is a condition of PUC authority and is committed to maintaining coverage at all times to ensure compliance and protect passengers, drivers, and the public.

Application Question 10: Financial Data

Explanation of Financial Capability

Answer:

La Bella Transportation LLC has sufficient financial resources to initiate and sustain paratransit transportation operations in a safe, reliable, and compliant manner. The applicant has evaluated anticipated startup and ongoing expenses, including vehicle maintenance, fuel, insurance premiums, licensing fees, and administrative costs, and has ensured that adequate liquid funds are available to cover these obligations.

The company maintains an active business bank account with sufficient cash reserves to support daily operations and to absorb routine operational expenses without service interruption. Insurance costs have been reviewed with licensed commercial insurance providers, and premiums have been incorporated into the company’s financial planning to ensure continuous coverage as required by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

In addition, the applicant’s experience in transportation management and business operations supports prudent financial oversight, cost control, and budgeting practices. These combined factors demonstrate the applicant’s financial fitness and ability to provide consistent, safe paratransit services to the public.
