Dear Mr. Martin:

Thank you for your Formal Complaint in which you identify “Philadelphia Electric Company (PECO), Verizon, and Comcast” as the utilities or companies about which you are complaining. Additionally, you indicated in your Formal Complaint that Verizon was a “telco” company and Comcast was a “cable” company. While the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission does regulate PECO, and Verizon PA, LLC, please be aware that the Commission does not have jurisdiction over Comcast cable television services, or any cable television services provided by Comcast. Therefore, your formal complaint will be accepted and processed against only PECO and Verizon PA, LLC, but is rejected as to any claims against Comcast.

You may be able to seek legal redress in a different legal forum such as a Magisterial District Court or your county’s Court of Common Pleas, or the Federal Communications Commission to move forward with your claims against Comcast.

We are sorry the Commission cannot be of further assistance to you regarding your claims against Comcast.
