FAILURE TO APPEAR. Failure of a party to attend the conference, without good cause shown, shall constitute a waiver of all objections to the agreements reached at the conference and to an order or ruling with respect thereto. Parties that do not participate in the prehearing conference may also be removed from the service list for this proceeding.

CONTINUANCES. You may request a continuance of the prehearing conference if you have a good reason. All continuances will be granted only for good cause. To request a continuation, you must file a written motion at least five (5) days before the hearing. Your motion should include: 1) The case name, number, and hearing date; 2) The reason for the request; and 3) Whether the other parties agree (or if you do not know).

REPRESENTATION. If you are an individual, you may represent yourself or you may have an attorney represent you. All others, including a partnership, corporation, limited liability company, trust, association, or governmental agency or subdivision, must be represented by an attorney licensed to practice law in Pennsylvania, or admitted *pro hac vice*. Only an attorney may represent someone else.
