Re: State Tax Adjustment Surcharge

Secretary Homsher:

Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. ("Columbia") files this letter notifying the Commission that Columbia will continue to apply the State Tax Adjustment Surcharge ("STAS") of 0.00%. The STAS provision of Tariff Gas - Pa. P.U.C. No. 9 of Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. ("Columbia") states that the STAS surcharge shall be recomputed whenever the following occur:

- a) Whenever any of the tax rates used in calculation of the surcharge are changed;
- b) Whenever the utility makes effective increased or decreased non-Purchased Gas Cost rates; and
- c) By March 31, 1971 and every year thereafter.

Columbia is submitting this letter pursuant to subpart (c), which requires that the STAS surcharge be recomputed by March 31 of every year.
