Dear Parties:

Applicant filed its Application for Motor Common Carrier or Motor Contract Carrier of Household Goods In Use on October 21, 2025 (Application). On November 24, 2025, a Protest to the Application was filed. On November 26, 2025, a Secretarial Letter denying the Application was issued. Applicant then filed a Petition for Reconsideration of Staff Action on December 16, 2025. Thereafter, on various dates from December 23, 2025 through February 16, 2026, numerous answers, reply to answers, and correspondence were filed to the docket as well.

Notwithstanding the above docketed items, Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 3.381(b), “[a]pplications will be docketed by the Secretary and ... thereafter forwarded for publication in the Pennsylvania Bulletin. No other notice to the public or to a carrier, forwarder or broker is required[.]” Once notice is published in the Bulletin, “[a] protest shall be filed within the time specified in the notice appearing in the Pennsylvania Bulletin, which shall be no less than 15 days from the date of publication.” 52 Pa. Code § 3.381(c)(ii).

Upon reviewing the docket in the above referenced matter, it has come to my attention that the Commission did not publish the Application in the PA Bulletin as required by Section 3.381(b). Accordingly, in order to cure any due process issues potentially created by the failure to publish notice of the Application, the Commission is hereby Rescinding its November 26, 2025 Secretarial Letter. Additionally, the Commission will publish notice of the Application in the February 28, 2026 PA Bulletin establishing a new protest period ending March 16, 2026.

Moreover, since one party has already filed a protest to the Application, the Commission will accept that filing as a protest. The protester does not need to, and should not, file another protest to the Application.

Finally, because the November 26, 2025 Secretarial Letter is hereby rescinded, the Applicant’s Petition for Reconsideration is now deemed moot.
