Pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.94(b), Zito Media Communications, LLC (“Zito”) hereby files this Notice of Withdrawal of Protest to withdraw the protest it filed on March 21, 2025 (“Protest”) opposing Everstream Solutions, LLC’s (“Everstream”) Application to abandon public utility service in the above referenced docket (“Application”).
