

- 1.) Question #10 of your application asks, "What type of commodities do you intend to transport other than your own?" Your answer, "Property excluding household goods".

A) Please describe "property" in more detail.

The term "property" refers to general freight transported for commercial customers utilizing dry van equipment. Commodities will include palletized and packaged goods such as retail and wholesale merchandise, non-perishable packaged food products (non-temperature controlled), paper and packaging materials, electronics, industrial supplies, and other non-hazardous general commodities typically transported in dry van trailers.

AI Trucking Inc will transport general freight for hire and will not transport household goods, personal effects associated with moving services

B) Describe your utility service in detail.

AI Trucking Inc will operate as a for-hire motor carrier providing non-household goods transportation services utilizing a dry van semi-truck. The company will transport general freight for commercial customers on a scheduled or as-needed basis. Operations will primarily consist of local and short-haul transportation within Pennsylvania, including pickup and delivery services between warehouses, distribution centers, manufacturers, and commercial facilities. Freight transported will be non-hazardous general commodities. The applicant intends to provide reliable, safe, and efficient transportation services in compliance with all applicable federal and Pennsylvania regulations governing motor carriers

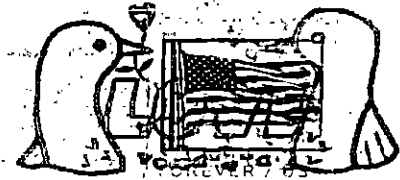
