NOTIFICATION OF PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION

Pursuant to the requirements of 52 Pa. Code § 59.38, National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation (“National Fuel”), hereby files the following Notification of Proposed Construction:

1. Description and Location of Proposed Work. National Fuel is planning to install approximately 2,150 feet of 2” and 1,450’ of 4” medium-pressure plastic pipeline in the City of Meadville, Crawford County, PA along Pine Street, Poplar Street, Liberty Street, South Main Street, Park Avenue, Pine Ally, Fairmont Street, Chancery Lane, Hemlock Street, and East Ally.

The project will be constructed by a National Fuel approved contractor.

2. Type of Facility. Installation of 2” and 4” medium-pressure plastic pipeline facilities.

3. Estimated Starting Date. Construction is expected to begin on or about March 25, 2026.

4. Estimated Completion Date. Construction is expected to be completed by September 30, 2026.

5. Design Pressure. The pipeline will be designed for a maximum allowable operating pressure of 60 psig.


6. Estimated Cost. The cost of the pipeline project is \$658,000.
