

Request for Information

- 1.) Question #10 of the application. Unfortunately, using words like “surrounding areas” is too vague and not allowed for a proper territory description. Please revise your territory request or verify that the below example is what you now intend.

**Example:** To transport household goods in use between points in Pennsylvania.

- 2.) Question # 3 of the Verified Statement. Submitted documentation should clearly demonstrate at least two years of employment (Sporadic paystubs are insufficient because they do not show no break in service). Typical submitted evidence is years’ worth of pay stubs, years’ worth of customer satisfaction for services rendered, or a letter written on the qualifying employer’s letterhead. This letter should be dated, include periods of your employment, work responsibilities, a signature by a previous company manager in accordance with 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904 (relating to unsworn falsification to authorities).

**(sample text below)**

I, \_\_\_\_\_, hereby state that the facts set forth are true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information and belief, and that I expect to be able to prove the same at a hearing held in this matter. I understand that the statements herein are made subject to the penalties of 18 Pa.C.S. § 4904 (relating to unsworn falsification to authorities).

- Additional methods of submitting evidence may also be acceptable; however, it is essential that they clearly demonstrate compliance with the statutorily required two years of experience.

3.) Question # 5 of the Verified Statement. Please review the requirements of the following chapters of 52 Pa Code and provide a required plan for drivers that demonstrates compliance with the below cited statutes.

A.) 52 Pa Code § 31.134 - Criminal history (Frequency of record check).

B.) 52 Pa Code § 37.204, 49 CFR 391.25 – Review of driver record (schedule).

C.) 52 Pa Code § 37.204, 49 CFR part 391.31 relating to training program.

What are the criteria for successful completion of training?

4.) Question # 8 of the Verified Statement. Please make sure a Form E can be provided to the PUC (when requested) with this policy, nothing else will be accepted.

5.) Financial Position.

A.) To fully assist the Commission in determining your financial fitness, please provide supporting documentation for the statement of financial position (balance sheet).

Acceptable means of support include current copies of bank statements (account numbers may be redacted), and notarized/official statements of account balances/ownership provided by bank officers (with current contact information).

- If the applicant (Remove and Restore Hauling Co) was previously unfunded, then now is the time for the applicant's accounts to be filled.

B.) You must also provide proof of ownership/registration in the name of *Remove and Restore Hauling Co* for the claimed vehicle.

7.) Are you familiar with the unique set up of a PA tariff with the weight and mileage chart (no binding estimates)?
