POST HEARING ORDER

The evidentiary hearing in this matter was held on February 2, 2026. All active parties were present and represented by counsel. At that time, the parties indicated that they were working towards a settlement in this proceeding. The parties requested that if a settlement was reached that they would be allowed to submit revised Phase V plan and statements in support by February 24, 2026. I told the parties that I would take that request under advisement.

On February 9, 2026, the parties via email notified me that the parties had reached a full settlement in this proceeding.

The procedural schedule is hereby modified as follows:

1. Each party must e-file and serve by email, prior to **4:30 p.m. February 24, 2026**, the revised/redline version of the Act 129 Phase V Energy Efficiency and Conservation Plan as well as any Statements in Support and/or Comments. That any settlement documents not filed and served on or before the date set forth above will not be accepted except by special permission;

2. That the Statements in Support filed alongside the revised/redline version of the Act 129 Phase V EE&C Plan shall explain, in substantial detail, why approval of the settlement by the Commission is in the public interest. In addition, the Statements in Support shall conform to the following requirements:

a. Technical terms and concepts are to be clearly defined and explained.

b. Statements in Support should be specific about how the settlement benefits your client. Boilerplate language regarding the general utility of settlements is not a substitute for an explanation of a party's support for the settlement.

3. That the parties are reminded that they are to e-mail the presiding officer a copy of their as-filed revised/redline version Phase V EE&C Plan, Statements in Support, Statements in Opposition, and/or Comments in a WORD-formatted document in addition to ADOBE or other compatible PDF format at mguhl@pa.gov;

4. That the parties are advised not to include any extra-record evidence in their settlement documents; and

5. That if any party fails to follow these instructions in the smallest detail, that party's position will not be considered, regardless of where the record may support it or the position of any other party to this proceeding.
