Transportation of Persons in Paratransit Service Between Points in Pennsylvania

*To transport, by motor vehicles, in Paratransit Service, persons between points in
Pennsylvania, excluding points in the counties of Bucks, Chester and Montgomery.*

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. Advance Reservations. Advance reservations for service must be made no later than 15 minutes prior to service being rendered.
2. Mileage. Rates for mileage are determined by the odometer of the vehicle in use and begin when the vehicle is loaded (i.e. the passenger is on board) and departs the origination point (i.e. the passengers home, facility or other departure point). The final round trip mileage reading is determined upon return to the origination point from the destination. Mileage is recorded to the nearest one-tenth of a mile, but is billed only in whole numbers. Mileage will be billed at the nearest whole number on a round trip basis (i.e. fractional mileage of 4 miles or less will be rounded down, and fractional miles of .5 or greater will be rounded up).
3. Expenses. Additional expenses necessitated by or incurred at the request of the passengers, including but not limited to, highway tolls, bridge tolls, entrance fees and parking, shall be added to the charge of the trip.
4. Service. Service is provided in vehicles capable of transporting passengers in paratransit service and capable of transporting passengers in a wheelchair or stretcher on a non-exclusive basis.
5. Holidays. The following holidays are subject to a holiday rate as listed in the Schedule of Rates: New Years Eve, New Years Day, Easter, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day.
6. Waiting Time. Wait time is charged pursuant to the schedule of rates for all time that vehicle personnel must wait for the passenger at the origin or destination. Wait time will be rounded to the nearest full minute and is billed only in full numbers.
7. Payment. Payment in full must be made prior to service being rendered, unless prior arrangements have been made with Solvere Transport, LLC.
8. Contract Services. Contract services will be for a term of not less than 30 days for pre-qualified persons under a federal, state, county or municipal government agency contract. Rates for the services will be specified in the respective contracts, copies of which, including any amendments thereto, are to be filed with the Commission as executed to become effective on one day's notice.

**SCHEDULE OF RATES
(Per Person)**

Base Rate: Standard Hours: 4:00 AM – 6:00 PM Monday through Friday
Wheelchair Van: \$ 85.00 each way.
Stretcher Van: \$200.00 each way.

Weekend, Evening & Holiday (Holidays listed in Rules & Regulations)
Wheelchair Van: \$100.00 each way.
Stretcher Van: \$250.00 each way.

Mileage: Mileage rates apply in addition to the base rates stated above on all loaded miles from the point of pick up to the point of drop-off.

A charge of \$5.00 per mile (or pro-rated portion thereof, rounded to the nearest mile on a round trip basis) from the point of pick-up to the final destination.

Wait time: The passenger will be charged at the rate of \$8.75 for every fifteen (15) minute increment, or any fraction thereof.

Attendant: An extra attendant shall be provided by reservation in those instances where necessary, according to the passenger's needs or condition. The charge for the extra attendant is \$50.00 per trip.

Stair Chair: An additional charge of \$60.00 will apply to all transports that require the use of a stair chair.
