**I. Executive Summary**

On August 16, 2024, UGI Utilities, Inc. – Gas Division (“UGI Gas” or the “Company”) filed its *Petition of UGI Utilities, Inc. – Gas Division for Approval of its Third Long-Term Infrastructure Improvement Plan* (“Third LTIIIP”) at Docket No. P-2024-3050769. The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission”) approved the Third LTIIIP in an Opinion and Order entered on December 5, 2024. As a result, this Annual Asset Optimization Plan (“2025-2026 AAOP”, “AAOP” or the “Plan”) covers the actual results from the first year of the Company’s Third Long-Term Infrastructure Plan (“LTIIIP”) and the anticipated replacements for the second year of the Third LTIIIP.<sup>1</sup> As discussed in more detail below, this 2025-2026 AAOP demonstrates that UGI Gas continues to make significant progress in replacing its aging infrastructure and equipment.

**II. Introduction**

Act 11 of 2012 (“Act 11”) authorized the Commission to approve a distribution system improvement charge (“DSIC”) upon petition by a public utility to recover the utility’s reasonable and prudent costs incurred to repair, improve or replace certain eligible distribution property that is part of the utility’s distribution system. As a precondition to implementing a DSIC, a utility is required to receive Commission approval for an LTIIIP that is consistent with the provisions of Section 1352 of the Pennsylvania Public Utility Code and the Commission’s regulations and implementing orders. Any utility with a DSIC is required to file an AAOP.

A utility’s AAOP is intended to provide the Commission and the public with an overall status report regarding a utility’s progress in making infrastructure improvements pursuant to its Commission-approved LTIIIP.<sup>2</sup> A utility’s AAOP must identify its near-term construction projects that will be funded by the DSIC, consistent with the LTIIIP.<sup>3</sup>

Specifically, 52 Pa. Code § 121.6 requires the AAOP to include: 1) a description of all eligible property repaired, improved and replaced in the immediately preceding 12-month period; and 2) a detailed description of all the facilities to be improved in the upcoming 12 months, pursuant to the utility’s LTIIIP.

### **III. Procedural History**

On August 16, 2024, UGI Gas filed its Third LTIIIP Petition.<sup>4</sup> The Third LTIIIP continued to build off the significant acceleration in the rate of infrastructure repairs, improvements and replacements, including the accelerated replacement of cast iron and bare steel pipe that was achieved by the Initial and Second LTIIPs, and reflects elements of further acceleration. In addition, UGI Gas has identified priority plastic pipe, installed between 1965 and 1985, for inclusion in the Third LTIIIP. During the five-year period of the Third LTIIIP, UGI Gas plans to invest approximately \$1.7 billion on infrastructure improvements that will strengthen and modernize distribution facilities servicing customers throughout the Company's service territory. With these investments, the Company anticipates replacing a total of 310-340 miles of cast iron, bare steel, wrought iron and priority plastic mains during the term of the Third LTIIIP. Continuing UGI Gas's infrastructure replacement program (as set forth in the Third LTIIIP) will allow the Company to provide safe and reliable service both now and into the future. These replacements will make the system safer, more reliable, and easier to operate. On December 5, 2024, the Commission issued an Opinion and Order approving the Company's Third LTIIIP.

### **IV. 2025-2026 AAOP**

This 2025-2026 AAOP is the first annual filing made by UGI Gas reporting on the progress made pursuant to its Third LTIIIP. The filing addresses the required elements for the Plan's 12-month period from January 1, 2025, through December 31, 2025. Additionally, this filing addresses the upcoming 12-month period from January 1, 2026, through December 31, 2026. The upcoming 12-month period is the second year of the Company's Third LTIIIP. This AAOP demonstrates that the Company's performance generally meets or exceeds the schedule of repairs, improvements or replacements of the specific eligible property in its approved Plan during the first year of the Third LTIIIP. This 2025-2026 AAOP also includes a comprehensive review of all cumulative DSIC eligible capital placed in service during the entirety of the Company's LTIIIP Program, including the Initial LTIIIP (i.e., 2014 to 2019), the Second LTIIIP (i.e., 2020 to 2024) and the first year of the Third LTIIIP (i.e., 2025).

#### **A. Description of Eligible Property Repaired, Improved, Replaced and Retired in the 12-Month Period: January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025**

The 2024-2025 AAOP identified a target of between 50 and 60 miles of combined cast iron, bare steel, wrought iron and priority plastic mains for replacement or retirement.<sup>5</sup> The location of the main replacements were selected through an annual process to evaluate and prioritize risk across the UGI Gas service territory. An annual review is performed to identify the highest risk pipe segments and prioritize those replacements each year. Risks are also re-evaluated over the course of the year as new information becomes available. This approach is consistent with the UGI Gas Transmission Integrity Management Program (“TIMP”) and Distribution Integrity Management Program (“DIMP”) filed in accordance with Subpart O of 49 C.F.R. Part 192 and Subpart P of 49 C.F.R. Part 192, respectively.

UGI Gas replaced 71.6 miles of cast iron, bare steel, wrought iron and priority plastic mains in the calendar year ended 2025.

Tables 1 and 2 below provide a summary of the miles of main replaced by UGI Gas in 2025.

Attached hereto as **Appendix A** is a list of DSIC-eligible main replacement projects completed during 2025. In addition, attached as **HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL Appendix C** is the project-level detail for 2025 replacement projects.

DSIC-eligible capital placed into service in calendar year 2025 totaled \$330.5 million, which exceeded the \$315.5 million estimate as shown in last year’s AAOP. For 2025, the Company’s LTIP planned spend and capital placed into service are reflected in Table 3, below. The increase in capital placed into service is due mainly to the Company exceeding its main replacement program goals by 11.6 miles. In calendar year 2025, the Company abandoned approximately 3.6 miles of a section of wrought iron and bare steel main in the northern part of

the Company’s service territory, which was necessary due to corrosion. This abandonment is part of a larger project that will retire approximately 15 miles of high pressure wrought iron and bare steel. While the entire 15 miles was originally planned to be abandoned in calendar year 2027, 3.6 miles were able to be completed in 2025. The Company also exceeded its planned service replacements in 2025, spending approximately \$10 million incrementally year over year as part of its meter relocation initiative required by 52 Pa. Code § 59.18, which mandates that certain indoor meter facilities be moved outside by 2034.

**B. Description of Cumulative LTIP Program Capital Placed in Service and Pipe Replacement Quantities: January 1, 2014 – December 31, 2025**

UGI Gas has included the following metrics that demonstrate: 1) cumulative capital for infrastructure placed in service; and 2) cumulative pipe replacement mileage since the inception of the Initial LTIP.

Table 5 below shows the planned and actual replacement figures for UGI Gas for the six years of the Initial LTIP, the five years of the Second LTIP, as well as the first year of the Third LTIP.

Table 6 below provides the total miles of main that the Company plans to replace during each year of the Third LTIP, as well as the actual mileage completed to date. UGI Gas has exceeded the estimate of the first year of its Third LTIP by replacing 71.6 miles of total cast iron, bare steel, wrought iron, and priority plastic mains in the calendar year ended December 31, 2025 compared to the Third LTIP’s plan of 50 to 60 miles.

**C. Description of Eligible Property To Be Repaired, Improved and Replaced in the Upcoming 12-Month Period: January 1, 2026 – December 31, 2026**

The calendar year ending December 31, 2026 will be the second year of the Company’s Third LTIP. The Company anticipates replacing between 60 and 70 miles of cast iron, bare steel, wrought iron and priority plastic main across its service territory. The estimates are reflected in Tables 7 and 8, below, which show main replacement quantities and DSIC-eligible capital spend forecasted for calendar year 2026. The estimated DSIC-eligible capital spend in 2026 is \$311.8 million.

UGI Gas is forecasting a decrease of approximately \$19 million below the planned capital spending identified in the Third LTIP for calendar year 2026. The calendar year 2026 planned capital is forecasted to realign with the overall planned spending within the five-year LTIP plan.

Attached hereto in **Appendix B** is a list of DSIC-eligible main replacement projects that are planned to go into service during calendar year 2026. **Appendices C and D** provide project-level detail for 2025 and 2026 replacement projects and include **HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL** information. The Company will file a public and highly confidential version of the AAOP and will mark Appendices C and D **HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL** in accordance with Commission requirements for the filing of confidential information.

The Company has included an analysis of restoration costs, consistent with its commitment in the 2025 UGI Gas base rate case settlement at Docket No. R-2024-3052716. The analysis is included as **Appendix E**. The Company will file a public and confidential version of the AAOP,
