Request for Information

- 1.) Your description provided on this current application for Call or Demand Authority states: “To transport persons requiring non-emergency medical transportation, including individuals with disabilities, seniors, and other mobility-limited passengers, upon call or demand on a pre-arranged basis between points in Montgomery County, Pennsylvania, and to and from points within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.” In this paragraph you clearly describe paratransit services. Note that Call or Demand services must be available by telephone or hail, which is not necessarily pre-arranged. Call or demand services are not allowed to work with NEMT transportation brokers in PA. Call or demand services cannot be limited to non-emergency medical transportation. The vehicle must also have a meter and a dome light for call or demand services. These are requirements, there are no exceptions.
