**INTERIM ORDER  
SETTING SCHEDULE FOR FILING STATUS REPORTS**

This Interim Order memorializes the schedule for PECO Energy Company to file status reports regarding a project intended to improve Complainant’s reliability concerns.

History of the Proceeding

On November 19, 2025, Brad Nickerson (Mr. Nickerson or Complainant) filed a Complaint against the Company.<sup>1</sup> Mr. Nickerson checked two boxes: (1) he is having a reliability, safety or quality problem with his utility service; and (2) “other” as the reasons for his Complaint.

On December 10, 2025, PECO filed an Answer with New Matter and a Preliminary Objection. In its Answer, PECO denied the material allegations of the Complaint.

On January 12, 2025, a Motion Judge Assignment Notice was issued informing the parties that I was assigned as the Presiding Officer responsible to resolve any issues which may arise during the preliminary phase of the proceeding.

On January 22, 2026, I issued an Order granting PECO's Preliminary Objection.

On January 22, 2026, the Commission issued a Hearing Notice, setting this matter for an evidentiary hearing on February 24, 2026.

On February 24, 2026, the hearing convened as scheduled. Mr. Nickerson appeared, *pro se*. Ms. Margaret Morris, Esq., appeared on behalf of PECO, along with four witnesses. The court reporter was also present. Prior to the start of the hearing, Mr. Nickerson and Ms. Morris agreed to allow me to serve as Settlement Judge. Settlement discussions were fruitful: PECO proposed to undertake a project during the summer months of 2026. To allow time for PECO to complete the proposed project, and to allow time for Mr. Nickerson to determine if the project satisfies his Complaint, PECO agreed to file a series of status reports.

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That PECO Energy Company shall file a series of status reports, as follows: (1) on or before May 22, 2026; (2) on or before August 28, 2026; and (3) on or before December 4, 2026.
2. That, if necessary or requested by either party, a status conference will be scheduled.
