ORDER
TRANSFERRING UNPROTESTED APPLICATION TO THE
BUREAU OF TECHNICAL UTILITY SERVICES

Background

On March 5, 2025, Everstream Solutions, LLC (“Everstream”) filed an application to abandon public utility service with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission.

On March 24, 2025, Zito Media Communications (“Zito”) filed a Protest to the Abandonment Application.

On April 10, 2025, Everstream filed a response to the Protest of Zito.

Also, on April 10, 2025, T-Mobile USA, Inc. (“T-Mobile”) filed a Protest to the Abandonment Application.

On April 30, 2025, Everstream filed a response to the Protest of T-Mobile.

On August 7, 2025, a Prehearing Conference was held.

On August 18, 2025, Everstream filed a Motion for Summary Judgment (“motion”).

Beginning on September 1, 2025, the assigned administrative law judges (“ALJs”) granted Zito and T-Mobile several extensions to answer the motion by email.

On December 18, 2025, T-Mobile filed an Unopposed Motion for Indefinite Stay of Proceedings in Furtherance of Settlement and Request to Waive Answer Period.

On December 19, 2025, the assigned ALJs issued an Order granting an indefinite stay of proceedings and waiving the 20-day answer period to the motion. The Order also directed the parties to file status updates at 60-day intervals.

On January 6, 2026, T-Mobile filed a Notice of Withdrawal of Protest based on T-Mobile no longer being an Everstream customer.

On February 20, 2026, Zito filed a Notice of Withdrawal of protest based on Zito's claim that it was working to resolve its differences with Everstream in an alternate forum.

Disposition

On February 3, 2025, Everstream served a Notice of Discontinuation of All Services in Pennsylvania on all its customers. Thereafter, on March 5, 2025, Everstream filed its application to abandon service with the Commission. The only protests filed in this matter were submitted by Zito and T-Mobile.

Section 5.94(b), 52 Pa. Code § 5.94(b), provides that, “[a] protest to an application may be withdrawn by filing a notice of withdrawal directed to the Commission or the presiding officer. The notice must state that the protest is withdrawn and provide the reasons for the withdrawal.”

Both Zito and T-Mobile have filed notices to withdraw their protests of Everstream's application to abandon public utility service and provided reasons for the withdrawal. Because both protests provide sufficient reason for their withdrawal and no other protests were filed in this proceeding, the matter will be assigned to the Bureau of Technical Utility Service (“TUS”).

Treating Everstream's application as unopposed is appropriate in this circumstance and will dispense with the need for hearings and briefs, saving the Commission, Everstream, Zito and T-Mobile, costs in time and money. The matter will therefore be reassigned to TUS.

ORDER

THEREFORE,

IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's Secretary's Bureau reassign the Application of Everstream Solutions, LLC for the Approval of the Discontinuance of Competitive Access Services at Docket No. A-2025-3053757, from the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's Office of Administrative Law Judge to the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission's Bureau of Technical Utility Services for any further action.
