Re: Hackney v. PECO Energy Company, Philadelphia Gas Works, Philadelphia Water Department

On January 14, 2026, an Initial Decision was entered in the above referenced docket. The Initial Decision was served on the parties the same day. Exceptions to the Initial Decision were due on or before February 3, 2026. Also on February 3, 2026, PECO Energy Company (PECO) filed a letter indicating it did not intend to file exceptions. At that time, Complainant had not filed exceptions. Consequently, on February 17, 2026, the Commission entered its Final Order.

Notwithstanding the above, it has come to the Commission's attention that Complainant filed a document that purports to be exceptions to the Initial Decision. On February 6, 2026, the Commission received Complainant's purported exceptions via First-Class Mail. The envelope in which the purported exceptions were filed is dated February 4, 2026.

In order to ensure due process and full review of the Initial Decision by the Commission, the Commission's February 17, 2026 Final Order is hereby RESCINDED. Further, the Complainant's purported exceptions will be accepted and presented to the Commission for disposition as it deems appropriate.


Additionally, it also appears that Complainant has failed to serve his purported exceptions on the Respondent. Consequently, to correct the service deficiency, I am hereby serving a copy of the Complainant's filing upon Respondent under cover of this Secretarial Letter.

Finally, parties have 10 days to file reply exceptions. See 52 Pa. Code § 5.535(a). Accordingly, Respondent will have 10 days from the date of this letter, or until March 9, 2026, to file reply exceptions, if any, to Complainant's purported exceptions.¹

¹ PECO's reply exceptions would be due March 7, 2026. However, because March 7, 2026, is a Saturday, the reply exceptions would be due the following Monday March 9, 2026. See 52 Pa. Code § 1.12(a).
