Dear Parties:

On February 25, 2026, CleanChoice Energy, Inc. (CleanChoice) filed a Letter Request for an extension until March 9, 2026, to file a response or Certificate of Satisfaction to Complainant's Formal Complaint. The original response was due February 25, 2026.
