We ensure prompt, comfortable transport to vital healthcare appointments, promoting consistent care and independence. Starting in Central PA, with plans to expand to Philadelphia and Pittsburgh areas.

Examples:

- *To transport people whose personal convictions prevent them from owning or operating motor vehicles from points in Lancaster County to points in PA, and return.*
- *To transport people from the city and county of Philadelphia to correctional facilities in PA, and return.*
- *To transport people in wheelchair and stretcher vans from points in the city of Pittsburgh to points in Allegheny County, and return.*
- *To transport people between points in Northumberland County.*

With over eight years of direct experience as an Uber driver, I possess extensive practical knowledge in the daily operation of a transportation service, including passenger safety, navigation, and regulatory compliance. My background as an executive manager for Central PA United and general secretary for SAC Charities honed my leadership and operational oversight skills. Furthermore, my network includes current rideshare drivers and owners of similar businesses, ensuring a ready workforce. My Bachelor's degree in Mathematics and Data Analysis from ASU provides a strong foundation for route optimization and business analysis.

Meetings will be held at the address indicated. A dedicated company phone device is used for communication. Bookings and correspondence are also managed using a laptop dedicated to the company's work. The company also intends to expand its operations to multiple locations across the state to provide its service to the largest number of the state's citizens.

- e. Drug/alcohol policy: Absolutely no alcohol or drug use permitted, with pre-employment and random testing.
