Dear Secretary Homsher:

Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. (“Columbia”) files this letter to notify the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission of the transfer of one residential customer.

Pursuant to Ordering Paragraph No. 1 of the Public Utility Commission’s July 12, 1977 Order, Columbia advises that the transfer of one residential customer located at 435 Georgetown Road, Darlington, PA 16115, falls under the category of “elimination of duplication of facilities.” The transfer to Peoples Natural Gas Company LLC (“Peoples”) is expected to occur by May 2026.

Columbia first notified the customer of the proposal to transfer their gas service to Peoples’ facilities on January 14, 2026. The customer did not object to the transfer.

I am copying counsel for Peoples on this Notification as well.
