1. Please provide the current status of the proposed contract for the transportation of electricity from Orange and Rockland Utilities, including the most recent draft and/or executed version.
2. Please provide a quantitative analysis supporting Pike's statement that the proposed procurement modification will not have a material impact on rates or service. Please include comparison modeling, if available.
3. Please clarify whether Enel X Advisory Services USA, LLC (Enel X), or any of its affiliates, is licensed as an Electric Generation Supplier in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
4. Please state whether Enel X or any of its affiliates intends to submit a bid in Pike's competitive solicitation for default service supply for the September 1, 2026 – May 31, 2027, period.
5. Please describe whether Enel X, or any of its affiliates, has any financial interest in, or maintains any contractual or other business relationship with any potential suppliers participating within the New York Independent System Operator that may submit a bid in this solicitation. If so, please provide a detailed explanation of the nature, scope, and extent of such financial interests or contractual relationships.
6. Please describe the compensation structure between Pike and Enel X, including whether compensation is fixed, hourly, transaction-based, success-based, or otherwise contingent upon the selection of any specific bidder.
7. Please describe the procedures, safeguards, or internal controls that will be implemented to ensure that the competitive bid process is conducted in a fair, transparent, and non-discriminatory manner, including any safeguards between Enel X and potential bidders.
