Request for Information

- 1.) In your response to question #10 of the application, you stated that you wished to transport individuals “between any county in Pennsylvania, from points primarily in Philadelphia County, Lehigh County, and Allegheny County and adjacent counties and return.” You have indicated a territory that covers a vast expanse along with area(s) that are heavily populated, with plans to only initially deploy 1 to 3 vehicles.
  - a. How do you intend to provide safe, efficient, and reasonable service to so many potential clients with such limited vehicle resources, and;
  - b. With only one proposed local operational presence (planned for the Philadelphia metro area)?

- Please note - the Commission will not approve authority requests that exceed your ability to provide safe, efficient, and reasonable service. You may wish to limit your service area to match your resources more appropriately. Also, bear in mind that additional territory can be added as additional resources become available to sustain the desired additional territory.
- 2.) In your application you mention that the operational model partners with “owner-operators.” Please explain what this model entails. Be advised – the Commission **does not** allow the use of independent contractors except under the use of a lease for carriers operating with call or demand authority.
- 3.) You failed to adequately answer all aspects of question #5 of the Verified Statement of Applicant. **Please review Title 52 Pa Code §29.501-509 Driver Regulations to see what is required of motor carriers.**
  - a. Your system for conducting criminal background checks; **(Title 52 Pa Code §29.505 – Criminal History)**
    - i. How will you maintain records (record retention) of the criminal background checks performed?
  - b. Your system for conducting driver license/history checks; **(Title 52 Pa Code §29.504 – Driver History)**
    - i. How will you maintain records (record retention) of such checks?
