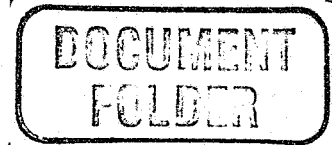

BY THE COMMISSION:

By application filed on June 4, 1992, Paging Network of Pittsburgh, Inc. seeks a certificate of public convenience pursuant to Section 1102(a)(1)(i) of the Public Utility Code evidencing Commission approval of the right to furnish one-way mobile radio-telephone service to the public in the 900 MHZ frequency band within the reliable service area of new transmitters located at Sharon, Mercer County and Utica, Venango County as defined by 20 mile radius contour maps submitted with the application. Notice of filing of the application was published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin. No protests were filed and no hearing was held. No motions or petitions have been filed in this proceeding.

Applicant is a Delaware corporation which furnishes mobile radio-telephone paging service in the Pittsburgh area pursuant to a certificate of public convenience issued at A. 330013. Applicant has received Federal Communications Commission authorization to construct and operate new transmitters at Sharon, Mercer County and Utica, Venango County. The new transmitters will expand Applicant's wide area paging network.

The estimated cost of the new facilities is \$60,000 which will be financed by Applicant's parent company, Paging Network, Inc. Applicant has personnel with the technical, financial and managerial experience to operate the proposed facilities. Applicant will charge the rates on file with the Commission for service in the additional areas.

Upon full consideration of all matters of record, we find approval of this application to be in the public interest; THEREFORE,


IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the application of Paging Network of Pittsburgh, Inc. is hereby approved.

2. That a certificate of public convenience be issued authorizing applicant to furnish one-way paging service to the public within the reliable service area of transmitters located at Sharon, Mercer County and Utica, Venango County as defined by 20 mile radius contour maps submitted with the application.

3. That within 90 days of the entry date of this order Applicant file with the Tariff Section of the Office of Special Assistants a tariff supplement to include the areas hereby certificated.
