



BY THE COMMISSION:

By this application filed on May 10, 1993 Paging Network of Pittsburgh, Inc. seeks a certificate of public convenience pursuant to Section 1102(a)(1)(i) of the Public Utility Code, evidencing Commission approval of the right to furnish one-way mobile radio-telephone service to the public within the reliable service area of six new transmitters to be located in West Brownsville, Johnstown, Franklin, Altoona, all in Pennsylvania and in Bridgeport, Ohio. Notice of filing of the application was published in the Pennsylvania Bulletin. No protests were filed and no hearing was held. No motions or petitions have been filed in this proceeding.

Applicant is a Delaware corporation which furnishes mobile radio-telephone paging service in the western portion of Pennsylvania pursuant to certificates of public convenience issued at A. 330013, Folders 1 through 3. Applicant has received authorization from the Federal Communications Commission to construct and operate new transmitters at Johnstown, Franklin and Altoona and applications are currently pending with the Federal Communications Commission for construction and operation of transmitters at West Brownsville, Pennsylvania and Bridgeport, Ohio.

The estimated cost of the new facilities is \$144,420 which will be financed by applicant's parent company, Paging Network, Inc. Applicant has personnel with the technical, financial and managerial experience to operate the facilities. Applicant will charge the rates on file with the Commission for service in the additional area.

Upon full consideration of all matters of record, we find approval of this application to be in the public interest; THEREFORE,


IT IS ORDERED:

1. That the application of Paging Network of Pittsburgh, Inc. is hereby approved.

2. That a certificate of public convenience be issued authorizing applicant to furnish one-way paging service to the public within the reliable service area of six transmitters to be located near West Brownsville, Johnstown, Franklin and Altoona in Pennsylvania and Bridgeport, Ohio as shown on a 20 mile radius contour map submitted with the application.

3. That within 90 days of the entry date of this order applicant file with the Tariff Section of the Office of Special Assistants a tariff supplement to include the area certificated by this order.

Dear Mr. Alford:

On July 26, 1993, the Commission entered an Order in the above-referenced proceeding granting Paging Network of Pittsburgh, Inc.'s ("PageNet") application to extend its certificated service area within Venango, Cambria, Blair, Greene, Westmoreland and Washington counties. The Commission required that within ninety (90) days of the Order's entry date, PageNet file with the Tariff Section of the Office of Special Assistants a tariff supplement to include the newly certificated service areas.

PageNet's currently effective tariff already encompasses Venango, Cambria, Greene, Westmoreland and Washington counties. Therefore, no tariff revisions are being made with regard to these counties.

Blair county, however, is not included in PageNet's current tariff. Accordingly, enclosed are eight (8) copies of revised pages 1 and 3, expanding the application of the tariff to include Blair county.


