Dear Brittany Hirson:

We are pleased that USA Energy Marketing Corp. has applied for a license to provide Natural Gas Broker/Marketer Services on the distribution system of Columbia Gas of Pennsylvania, Inc. ("Columbia Gas").

Under Paragraph 2.4.5 of the Rules Applicable to Distribution Service section of the Tariff of Columbia Gas, USA Energy Marketing Corp. could be required to provide to Columbia Gas a bond or other financial security instrument in an amount that Columbia Gas determines to be appropriate. USA Energy Marketing Corp. has indicated only brokering and consulting services will be provided. Therefore, we have determined at this time that USA Energy Marketing Corp. does not need a bond or other financial security requirement to provide broker natural gas services to Columbia Gas customers.

If the creditworthiness requirement or Columbia Gas' exposure to USA Energy Marketing Corp. changes in the future, Columbia Gas might deem it appropriate to require USA Energy Marketing Corp. to provide a bond or other financial security instrument.

National Fuel Gas Distribution Corporation (“NFGDC”) is aware USA Energy Marketing Corp. (UEM) has filed an application with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to supply natural gas service to the public in Pennsylvania and specifically within the service territory of NFGDC.

As you know, in making such an application, UEM must furnish acceptable security to each utility where UEM will do business. As such, under its tariff, NFGDC could require UEM to provide a bond or other financial security instrument in an amount that NFGDC determines to be appropriate.

However, you have indicated, and it is NFGDC’s understanding that UEM intends only to provide natural gas aggregating, brokering and consulting services at this time. You have stated that, in performing these services, UEM will never take title to any delivered natural gas, nor will it accept any customer payments or deposits.

Based upon your representations, NFGDC has determined that, at this time, UEM does not need to post a bond or other form of security to operate in its service territory. However, if the services provided by UEM change in the future, NFGDC reserves the right to require security from UEM as it deems appropriate.

Dear Brittany Hirson:

PECO is aware that USA Energy Marketing Corporation has applied for a license to provide brokering and consulting services to commercial and industrial customers on the distribution system of PECO.

In making such an application USA Energy Marketing Corporation could be required to provide to PECO a bond or other acceptable financial security in an amount that PECO determines to be appropriate. USA Energy Marketing Corporation has indicated that it intends to provide only brokering and consulting services to commercial and industrial customers; will not take title to any delivered natural gas; nor will accept any customer payments or deposits.

Therefore, PECO has determined at this time that USA Energy Marketing Corporation does not need a bond or other financial security requirement, since they are not directly engaging in business with PECO and only providing brokering or consulting services to PECO customers. However, if the services provided by USA Energy Marketing Corporation, or the creditworthiness requirement for PECO's exposure to USA Energy Marketing Corporation changes in the future, PECO reserves the right to require USA Energy Marketing Corporation to provide a bond or other financial security instrument.

Based on your assertion that USA Energy Marketing Corp. (“USA Energy Marketing”) is applying with the State of Pennsylvania to operate as a natural gas broker/marketer, UGI Utilities, Inc.-Gas Division (“UGIU”) has concluded that USA Energy Marketing will not need to post security with UGIU. This is based on the declaration that USA Energy Marketing will be acting in conjunction with a licensed natural gas supplier who has been approved by the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to serve in the applicable UGIU service territories and who has posted the required financial security as specified in the UGIU Tariff. If USA Energy Marketing wishes to directly serve Choice customers in the service territories of UGIU in the future as a natural gas supplier, it will have to post security as specified in the UGIU Tariff prior to the commencement of the service.

Dear Ms. Hirson:

We understand that USA Energy Marketing Corp. has applied with the Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission to supply natural gas services to the public in Pennsylvania, including our company's service area.

Pursuant to 66 Pa.C.S. § 2208(c), an applicant for a natural gas supplier license must furnish security to each utility where it will do business to ensure the supplier's financial responsibility. To this end, Valley Energy periodically will perform a credit review and analysis of USA Energy Marketing Corp. when USA Energy Marketing Corp. begins to serve customers on Valley Energy's system. Valley Energy will determine whether USA Energy Marketing Corp. must post a security based on the credit review, the types of customers served, the volumes expected to be delivered for those customers and the other rules in Valley Energy's Supplier Tariff. At this time, no security is being requested; however, if the services provided change in the future, we reserve the right to require security from USA Energy Marketing Corp. as deemed appropriate.
