Enclosed for electronic filing please find the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement's ("I&E") **Amended Motor Carrier Formal Complaint** in the above-captioned matter. This Amended Complaint supersedes the Motor Carrier Formal Complaint filed and served at the above docket on October 30, 2025.

This Amended Complaint revises the originally-filed Complaint by removing the alleged violation regarding the mileage of a vehicle and revising the civil penalty sought from \$700 to \$600. The removal of this violation is solely based on Respondent's production of a Vehicle Inspection Report, dated September 29, 2025, from an automotive garage verifying the vehicle's mileage within the acceptable range, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §29.333(d). I&E disputes the assertion, set forth in Respondent's Answer, that Officer Drago reinspected and corrected the vehicle's mileage.

AMENDED MOTOR CARRIER COMPLAINT

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (“Commission” or “PUC”) is a duly constituted agency of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania empowered to regulate public utilities within the Commonwealth. The Commission has delegated its authority to initiate proceedings which are prosecutory in nature to the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement and other bureaus with enforcement responsibilities. Pursuant to that delegated authority and Section 701 of the Public Utility Code, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement – Motor Carrier Division hereby represents as follows:

1. That Economica Limousine Car Services LLC, Respondent, maintains its principal place of business at 653 Schuylkill Avenue, Reading, PA 19601.
2. That Respondent was issued a certificate of public convenience for limousine authority by this Commission on October 19, 2023, at PUC Utility Code No. 6426358.
3. That on July 7, 2025, PUC Motor Carrier Enforcement Officer David Drago conducted an annual inspection of vehicles on 6th and Spring Street in Reading, Berks County.
4. That at the time of the inspection, Respondent was operating ten vehicles.

5. That six out of ten of Respondent's vehicles were operating as limousines with a wheelbase less than the minimum requirement of 109 inches, violating 52 Pa. Code §29.333(b). The penalty for this violation is \$100 per vehicle, for a total of \$600.

WHEREFORE, the Bureau of Investigation and Enforcement hereby requests that the Commission fine ECONOMICA LIMOUSINE CAR SERVICES LLC the sum of six hundred dollars (\$600.00) for the illegal activity described in this Complaint and order such other remedies as the Commission may deem to be appropriate.
