RE: Pennsylvania-American Water Company Section 1329 Application for the Acquisition of the Indian Creek Valley Water Authority Water System at Docket No. A-2025-3055741

Dear Attorneys Triscari and Bakare:

The Pennsylvania Public Utility Commission (Commission) writes to inform you that, upon review of the supplemental materials provided, it has conditionally accepted for filing the above-captioned application, as amended (Application).

It will be necessary for Pennsylvania-American Water Company (PAWC) to serve copies of the Application upon the following entities and then file proof of such service with the Commission, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code §§ 1.57 and 1.58:

1. Each city, borough, town, township, county, and related planning office, which is included, in whole or in part, in the proposed service area;
2. Each water or wastewater utility, municipal corporation or authority which provides water or wastewater collection, treatment, or disposal service to the public and whose service area abuts or is within 1 mile of the service area proposed in the Application; and
3. The Office of Consumer Advocate, Office of Small Business Advocate, and the Department of Environmental Protection's central and appropriate regional office.

PAWC and Pennsylvania-American Water Company – Wastewater Division (PAWC-WD) are directed, upon receipt of this letter, to provide individualized notice of the proposed acquisition to all potentially affected PAWC and PAWC-WD customers, consistent with the Commission’s Final Supplemental Implementation Order entered July 2, 2024, at Docket No. M-2016-2543193. PAWC shall inform the Commission when it begins providing such individualized notice. PAWC is also directed to ensure concurrent notice to all current Indian Creek Valley Water Authority (ICVWA) water customers in similar fashion. Additionally, PAWC shall publish the notice once a week for two consecutive weeks in a newspaper having a general circulation in the area involved and file proof of publication with the Commission after publication has occurred.

Finally, PAWC shall further amend its Application to provide the following information as required in the Commission’s 66 Pa.C.S. §1329 Application Filing Checklist – Water/Wastewater 2024 Final Supplemental Implementation Order:

1. *Checklist Item No. 12 – Provide a proposed tariff containing a rate equal to the existing rates of the seller at the time of the acquisition and a rate stabilization plan, if applicable to the acquisition.* Revise the Application’s Appendix A-18-a to include a copy of the September 6, 2023, notice to the Pleasant Valley Water Authority of a rate change to \$17.00 per 1,000 gallons;
2. *Checklist Item No. 20.a. - Proof of Compliance. Provide proof of compliance with applicable design, construction and operation standards of DEP or of the county health department, or both, including: a. For water system acquisitions, provide copies of the public water supply/water quality management permits for the utility plant.* Revise the Application’s Appendix A-20-a to include written evidence from the Pennsylvania Department of Environmental Protection for approval of ICVWA to operate the Normalville and White Pump Stations (e.g., copies of public water supply construction and operation permits); and
3. *Checklist Item No. 25 – Provide a copy of all municipal and affiliate contracts to be assumed by buyer as part of the acquisition and a list and annual dollar value of other contracts.* Revise the Application’s Appendix A-25.2 to include a copy of Exhibit A of the Agreement for Water Service dated April 17, 1995, by and between Indian Creek Valley Water Authority and Mount Pleasant Township, referenced in Appendix A-25.2, Page 7.

The filing of these supplemental materials shall be verified pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 1.36. Upon completion of the conditions established herein, PAWC shall file a verification letter at this docket, indicating satisfaction of these conditions. The Commission will then issue a Secretarial Letter finalizing acceptance of the filing. After final acceptance of the filing, pursuant to 52 Pa. Code § 5.14, the Commission will proceed with publishing notice of the Application in the *Pennsylvania Bulletin*. This matter will receive the attention of the Commission and you will be advised of any further necessary procedure.

If you are dissatisfied with the resolution of this matter, you may, as set forth in 52 Pa. Code § 5.44, file a petition for reconsideration from the actions of staff with the Commission within 20 days of the date this letter is served.
